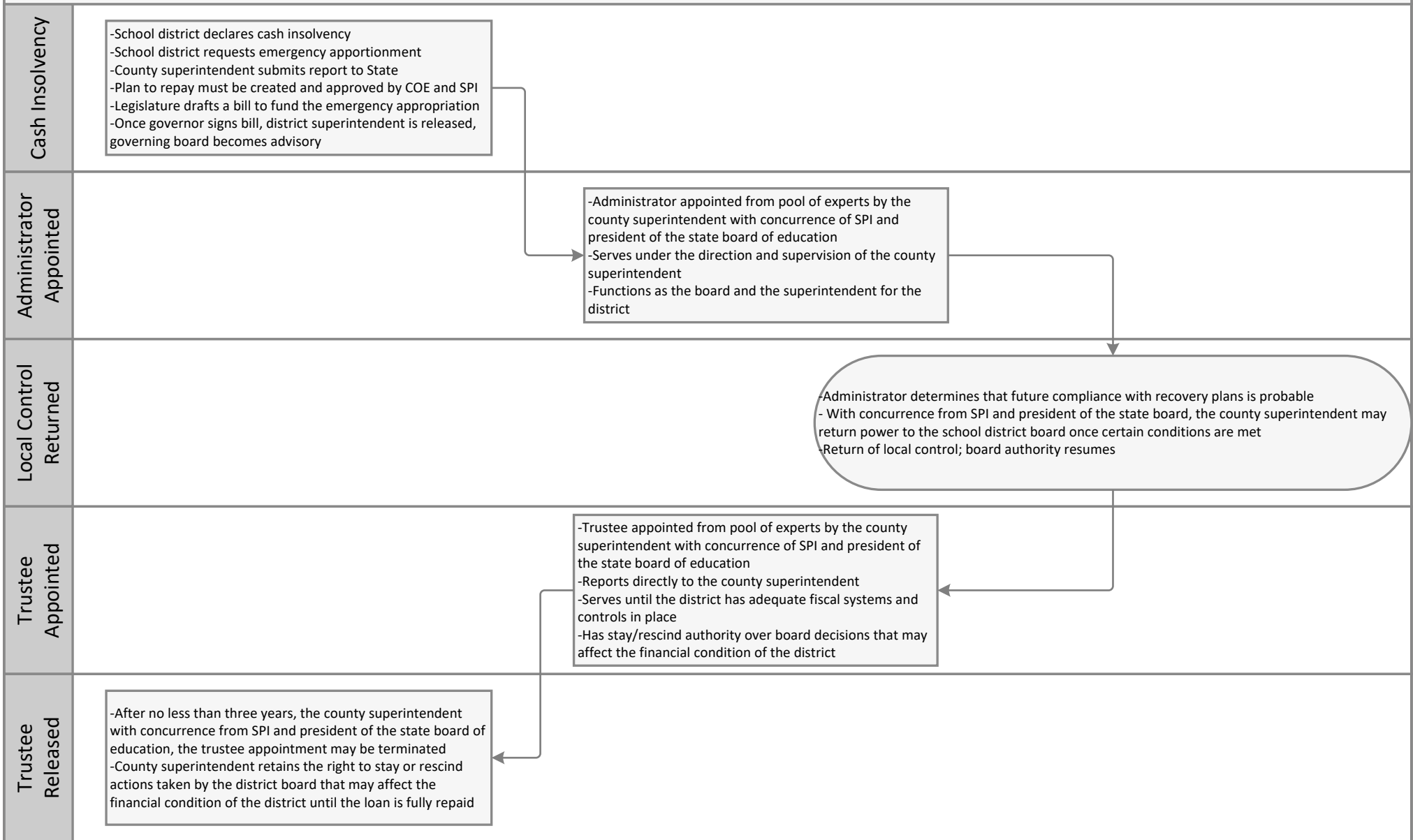


Emergency Appropriation Districts (Education Code 41320)



Note: Per EC 41326(h) If a district violates a provision of the approved recovery plan within **5 years** of release of trustee (or repayment of emergency apportionment, whichever is later), the county superintendent with concurrence of the SPI and president of the state board, may reassume either directly or indirectly via an administrator, all of the authority of the district school board as noted in "administrator appointed" section above. Return of local control to the district will only occur once future compliance with approved recovery plans is probably or after a period of one year, whichever occurs later.
