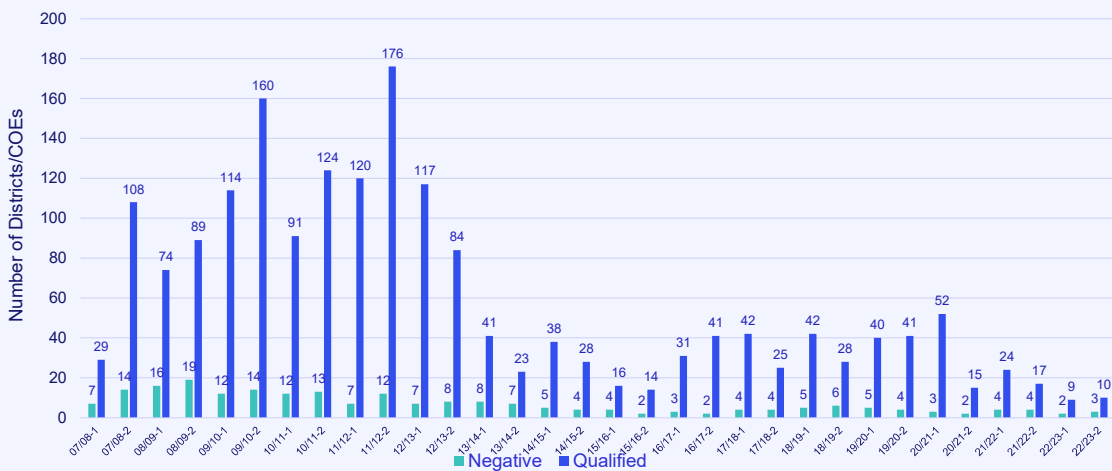

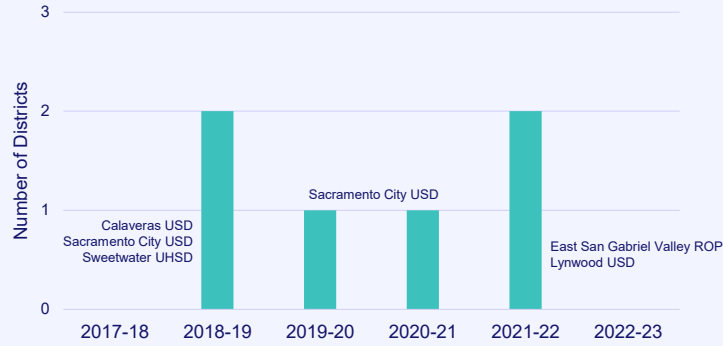

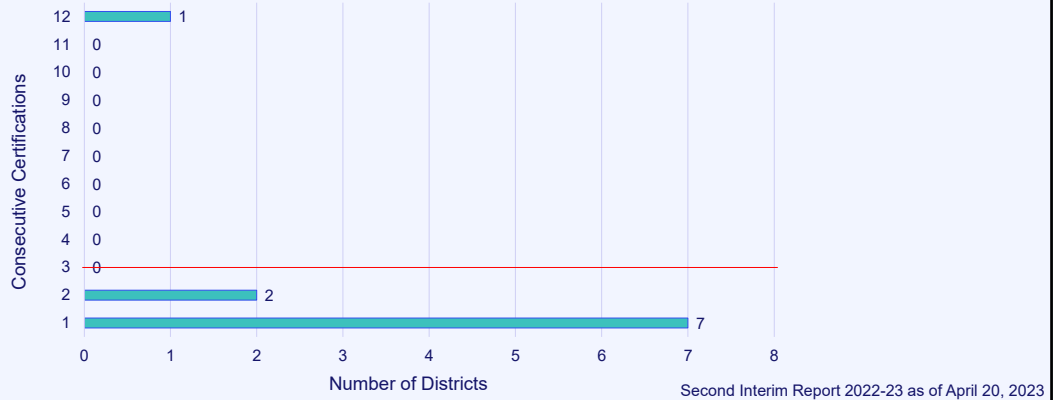
## Disapproved Budgets

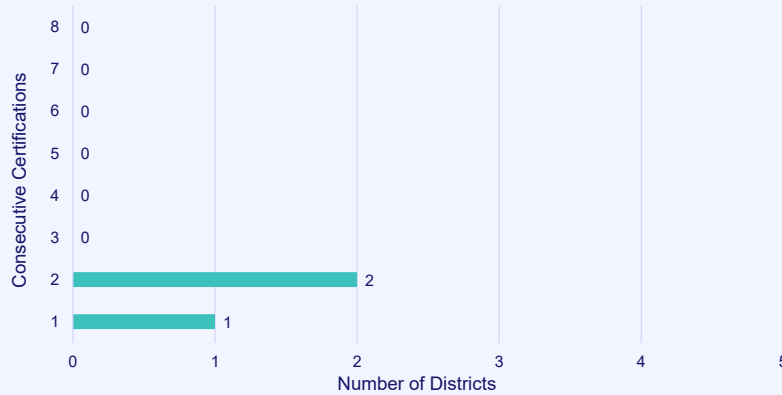

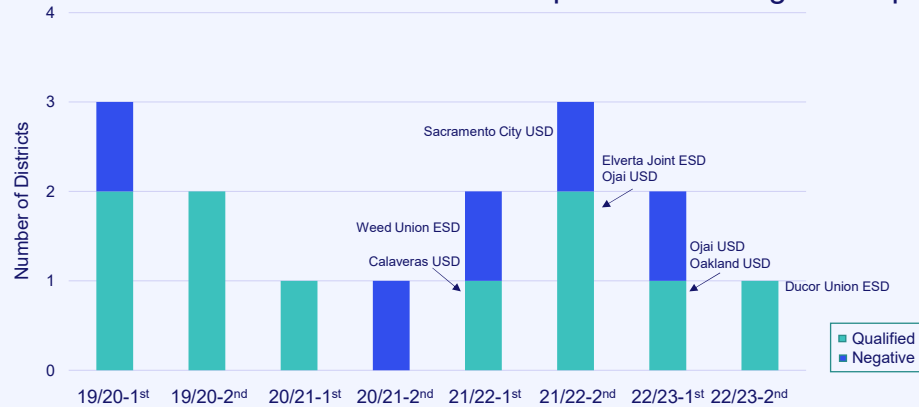

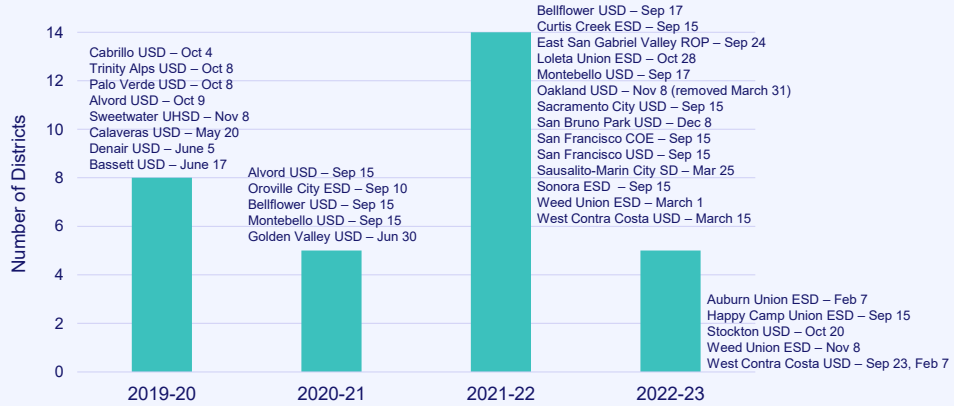
